The Federation is focused on New England philately. However, strictly speaking, there is no rule against member clubs being located outside of New England.

Club Benefits: The Federation provides a forum for the dissemination of philatelic information of importance to the New England area. We do this by providing a centralized list of member clubs and their exhibitions (i.e., each club gets their own page on the Federation website and club shows are listed on our events page). Clubs can even host their own website on the Federation web hosting account (e.g., Philatelic Group of Boston, Waltham Stamp Club, and Rhode Island Philatelic Society use this service – note however that clubs using this service are required to provide their own computer code). We also run a youth philately program and make frequent monetary donations to other philatelic organizations, most notably the Spellman Museum of Stamps and Postal History, the American Philatelic Research Library (APRL) and the American Philatelic Society (APS). Finally, the Federation stages the annual Philatelic Show every May at the Holiday Inn of Boxborough, Massachusetts. This is the World Series of Philately show (as defined by the APS) for New England. The Federation is considering a bid to host the twelfth International Philatelic Exhibition to be staged in the United States, scheduled for 2026.
